Think Pharmacy First

EVEN minor illnesses can disrupt your festive celebrations, but your local pharmacist is an expert source of health advice and can help you treat many common illnesses and minor ailments and injuries, such as coughs, colds, sore throats, blocked nose, fever, cold sores, skin rashes, eye infections, earache, diarrhoeateething and thrush — to name but a few.

With longer opening hours than the average GP practice and conveniently located, you can drop in without an appointment and ask for advice. Most pharmacists now have a separate consultation area too so you can discuss your symptoms in private.

Pharmacists can also dispense prescriptions and help advise you on a range of over-the-counter medicines you can stock up on at home but please make sure you allow at least a week before Christmas to order any prescriptions you know that you might need.

Symptoms of many common illnesses can last a lot longer than you think:

Ear infection - at least four days

Flu - two weeks

Sore throat - one week

Nasal congestion - two-and-a-half weeks

Cold - one-and-a-half weeks

Cough – up to three weeks

Remember antibiotics DO NOT help common winter ailments. Speak to your pharmacist first for advice on what's best for you.
