# Service developments

- CMHS
  - Development of Community Mental Health Well-being service
  - This will enable us to reduce the caseload within the CMHT and facilitate a more responsive service
  - Investing in more diverse community services will reduce the number of admissions to acute beds and improve our capacity to respond to people in a MH crisis



# Service developments

- Learning disabilities
  - Plans are underway to develop an integrated (health and social care) learning disabilities service
  - Implementing living well with a learning disability strategy
- Dementia Pathway
  - Shackleton ward has been refurbished / redesigned



# Service development

- Rehabilitation and reablement
  - Plan to reduce the number of beds required
  - Develop intensive community based rehabilitation service based on supported living framework and community support
- Acute services
  - Review the use of MH beds with the aim of increasing home treatment capacity
  - Ensure there are smooth transitions and continuity between community, acute and rehabilitation services.



# Future focus

- Work force review
  - Developing skill mix across the service and identifying training needs
- Clinical Pathways
  - Broaden our scope for delivering evidence based person centred care
  - Develop a psychologically minded workforce
- Staff well-being – looking at strategies for improving recruitment and retention
