### 1 Access BMJ Best Practice

#### Trust computer

#### Home Computer

Click [Log in](#) and select [Access through your institution](#). Type Isle of Wight NHS Trust in the [Find your organisation](#) search box (or NHS in England if it IoW Trust doesn't appear). Enter your OpenAthens credentials to access the content.

### 2 Set up a personal account

Ensure you are logged in through institutional access. Click [Create account](#) on the top right hand corner of the home page.

Search for 'BMJ Best Practice' on the App Store or Google Play and click download. Enter your personal account login details to complete the download.
